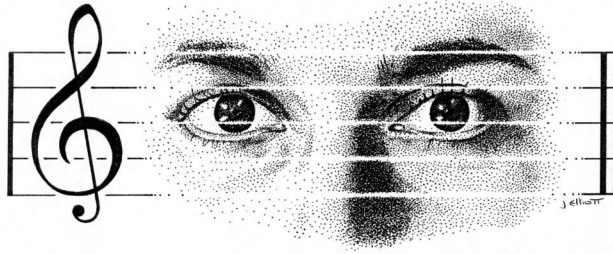

Lynn Skinner: Artist Bio/Statement

Lynn Skinner is a vocal performing artist who has shared her music with diverse audiences for over 30 years. After 10 years of classical and choral training, Lynn branched out in the late 70s to explore folk, musical theatre, jazz, and eclectic music that has continued to this day. Her diverse recordings reveal the range of her artistry, from jazz standards to movie music with string orchestrations; from 18th century French art songs to her own tunes about cats, clouds, children, and the quirky sides of love. She is also an accomplished voice trainer, coach and educator.

Lynn is currently interested in connecting with the audience in a sophisticated atmosphere. Lynn would prefer to sing in festivals, more intimate settings and elegant home/private concerts. Within that category, Lynn can offer jazz, Brazilian music, or special theme concerts featuring the repertoire of such greats as Duke Ellington or Joni Mitchell.
